



“Adopt-a-Dorm” Program

This is an exciting opportunity to partner with 7hills and “adopt” a dorm room at our transitional living facility located on Huntsville Road, called the Walker Family Residential Community (WFRC).

WFRC is a temporary home for up to 24 months for those who are making a commitment to participate in active case management and work toward gaining employment and stable housing. We are doing what we can to help them succeed, and your help in preparing a nice space for them while they work on their goals is greatly appreciated!

Each WFRC dorm is furnished with a twin bed, chest of drawers, a small locker, a writing desk and chair, a mini fridge, and cabinets for storage.



BUT...

with a fresh coat of paint, some new bedding and rug, and a little “love,” it can become a place that encourages a client to succeed!

We ask you to consider the following needs for each adopted room:

- Fresh coat of paint
- twin bedding (sheets/comforter/pillows)
- 5x7 area rug (our floors are cold, grey concrete)
- decor: faux plant, wall art, curtains, stationary, desk accessories, lamp, etc.
- small welcome mat; This is a great chance to make this a "homey" environment
- cork message board for the doors. (case manager messages, community messages, maintenance, etc.)

Church groups and community organizations will find this to be a perfect fit for a volunteer activity. Projects can be completed during working hours, or (with some planning in advance) an evening or weekend. New move-ins are typically scheduled at least 1-2 times each month. Adoptions are coordinated first with our Volunteer Coordinator and then with our Case Management staff at WFRC. Adoptions may be a one-time group opportunity or may also become a commitment of any length up to a year or more.
