"I didn't have a place to live," he says of his prior situation. "I couldn't afford to get a place, and my family wasn't able to help."



Casey is close with his mother, but she wasn't able to offer financial support. As Casey searched for work, his budget reached its breaking point. He was truly desperate for help.

You gave him somewhere to turn. Casey remembered a friend who also benefitted from your support by receiving housing assistance through 7hills. Casey reached out to us and was placed in our transitional housing dorm.

"[My situation] is looking up," says Casey.

He adds that his property manager, case manager and 7hills' program director continually listen to him and check in with him as he works to get back on solid footing.

"The thought of people in NWA not having a safe place to lay their head at night, calls me to action," Jo Kaye says of her decision to partner with 7hills. "NWA is a special place with a generous spirit that is always ready to help support a great cause. I want people to see homelessness as one of those great causes."

Jo Kaye has been supporting 7hills' mission for more than a decade. She began volunteering through her job at Walmart corporate and joined our Board of Directors in 2016.

Jo Kaye has a deep understanding of poverty in our community. She knows the issue is far more complex than many often think.

"There are a lot of misperceptions people make about homelessness," she says. "It's not as simple as getting up and getting a job — you can't pull yourself up by your bootstraps if you don't have a pair of boots."

Jo Kaye is now a professor at the University of Arkansas' school of business and recognizes that housing insecurity is a problem we can solve if we work together.

"If everyone is willing to give just a little of what they have, we can create an amazing success story for our area," she says. "Let's begin writing that story."

Nowadays she's focused on getting stable financially — and looking toward a brighter future. Her goal is to become a lawyer and buy a house for her family. Your support will help her get there.
